## ADDENDUM OFFICIAL GAME RULES PICK-6 LOTTO GAME RULES DOUBLE PLAY

The following rules have been adopted by the New Jersey State Lottery Commission pursuant to the authorization contained in N.J.S.A. 5:9-7 as an addendum to the rules governing the PICK-6 Lotto Game to govern the operation of the "Double Play" feature.

Unless otherwise defined or the context clearly indicates otherwise, all capitalized terms used in this Addendum shall have the same meaning as defined in the Official PICK-6 Lotto Game Rules. The Double Play feature will be administered under the Pick-6 Lotto Game Rules except as herein provided. The additional rules are as follows:

## 1. DEFINITIONS

Double Play - means a game feature that gives players the opportunity for an additional chance to win a separate set of prizes from a separate Prize Pool. For an additional $\$ 1.00$, the Lottery draws a second set of numbers, giving the player a second chance of winning with the same numbers played in the base Pick-6 Lotto Play for a separate set of prizes.

Double Play Drawing - means the formal draw event for randomly selecting the winning indicia that determine the number of winners for each prize level of the Double Play game.

Double Play Jackpot Prize - means the fixed prize amount of two-hundred-fifty thousand dollars $(\$ 250,000)$ for a Winning Play matching all six (6) of forty-six (46) of the Matrix. When there are multiple jackpot winners, the Jackpot Prize payout shall be determined on a pari-mutuel basis.

Double Play Winning Numbers - means the game results selected during a Double Play Drawing which shall be used to determine winning Plays contained on game ticket or ticketless transaction.

## 2. GAME PLAY

a. The Double Play option may be purchased for an additional $\$ 1.00$, per play, or multiples thereof in the case of a Multi-Draw Wager, at the discretion of the Purchaser.
b. The Pick-6 XTRA Multiplier affects Double Play Prize Levels two (2) through four (4). The Pick-6 XTRA Multiplier feature does not affect Double Play Prize Level 1 (Jackpot Prize).
c. The Double Play feature may not be cancelled once purchased.

## 3. DRAWINGS

a. The Double Play Winning Numbers are drawn from the same Matrix used for each Pick-6 Lotto Drawing. A Double Play Drawing will occur after every Pick-6 Lotto Drawing to determine the Double Play Winning Numbers.

## 4. PRIZE STRUCTURE

a. The expected Prize Pool for each Double Play drawing is approximately fifty-one percent (51\%) of the money wagered by all players, plus the carryover amount, if any. Double Play Prizes are as indicated in the grid below:

* The Jackpot is a fixed prize, but becomes pari-mutuel when there are multiple winners. Prize Levels 2 and 3 are parimutuel. The estimated prizes shown for Prize Levels 2 and 3 are based on the odds, expected sales, and number of winners for the prize level.

d. All Double Play Prizes, including the Double Play Jackpot Prize, shall be paid in one (1) payment.
e. In the event there are multiple Double Play Jackpot Prize winners for a draw, the Double Play Jackpot Prize payout shall be divided equally among the number of Jackpot Prize Winning Tickets. The Double Play Jackpot Prize shall be fixed at a non-annuitized two-hundred-fifty thousand $(\$ 250,000)$ value for every drawing. If in any Double Play drawing in which no Double Play Wager(s) qualify for the Double Play Jackpot Prize, the Double Play Jackpot Prize will remain fixed at the non-annuitized value of two-hundredfifty thousand $(\$ 250,000)$ for the subsequent drawings.
f. The Pick-6 XTRA Multiplier feature does not affect Double Play Prize Level 1 (Jackpot Prize). The Pick-6 XTRA Multiplier affects Double Play Prize Levels two (2) through four (4). Prizes for Double Play with XTRA are as follows:

## 5. RETAILER REQUIREMENTS, COMMISSIONS AND BONUSES

a. The Retailer(s) selling a winning six (6) out of forty-six (46) Double Play Jackpot Prize Winning Ticket shall receive a $\$ 2,500.00$ bonus from the Lottery.
