\$9.3 MILLION REASONS TO PLAY PICK-6 WITH XTRA Jackpot Rolls to \$9.3 Million for July 10 Drawing

TRENTON (July 7, 2017) – Although there was no top prize winner for the Thursday, July 6 Pick-6 game drawing, there were 13 ticketholders who won \$2,198 for matching five out of the six white balls drawn. Two of those tickets were purchased with the addition of XTRA, multiplying the prize to \$8,792. In addition, thousands of other prizewinning tickets were sold.

The winning numbers for the Thursday, July 6 drawing were: 11, 12, 15, 19, 22 and 46. The XTRA Multiplier was: 04. The jackpot for the Pick-6 XTRA game has rolled to \$9.3 million. The next drawing will be held Monday, July 10.

Executive Director Carole Hedinger announced that there were 571,677 tickets purchased for the drawing. By adding XTRA, for an additional \$1.00 per play, winners are able to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by the XTRA number drawn. For correctly matching four numbers, 596 ticketholders won \$47 each and 72 others won \$188 each with the addition of XTRA. Moreover, for correctly matching three numbers, 10,075 ticketholders won \$3.00 each and 1,413 others won \$12 each with the addition of XTRA. Lastly, 9,780 ticketholders each won \$2.00 for correctly matching two numbers with the addition of XTRA on their purchase.
