\$5.5 MILLION REASONS TO PLAY PICK-6 WITH XTRA Jackpot Rolls to \$5.5 Million for Dec. 28 Drawing

TRENTON (Dec. 27, 2017) – Although there was no top prize winner for the Tuesday, Dec. 26 Pick-6 game drawing, there were three ticketholders who won \$7,827 for matching five out of the six white balls drawn. One of those tickets was purchased with the addition of XTRA, multiplying the prize to \$23,481. In addition, thousands of other prizewinning tickets were sold.

The winning numbers for the Tuesday, Dec. 26 drawing were: 02, 24, 31, 36, 42 and 47. The XTRA Multiplier was: 03. The jackpot for the Pick-6 XTRA game has rolled to \$5.5 million. The next drawing will be held Thursday, Dec. 28.

Executive Director Carole Hedinger announced that there were 469,645 tickets purchased for the drawing. By adding XTRA, for an additional \$1.00 per play, winners are able to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by the XTRA number drawn. For correctly matching four numbers, 333 ticketholders won \$69 each and 38 others won \$207 each with the addition of XTRA. Moreover, for correctly matching three numbers 6,299 ticketholders won \$3.00 each and 761 others won \$9 each with the addition of XTRA. Lastly, 5,804 ticketholders each won \$2.00 for correctly matching two numbers with the addition of XTRA on their purchase.
