## **Powerball Jackpot Rolls to \$127,000,000 For Wednesday's Drawing**

**TRENTON (Jan. 29, 2018)** – While there were no New Jersey winners of the Powerball jackpot, second or third-tier prizes for the Saturday, Jan. 27 drawing, 30,707 New Jersey players took home an estimated \$154,468 in prizes ranging from \$4 to \$200, according to Lottery Acting Executive Director John M. White.

The winning numbers for the Saturday, Jan. 27 drawing were: 17, 21, 26, 47 and 54. The Red Power Ball number was 07. The Multiplier number was 02.

“Congratulations to all of the lottery players who purchased winning tickets and to the retailers that sold them,” said White. “I’d like to remind players to purchase their Powerball tickets with a winning attitude and add Power Play to the ticket purchase. Power Play doubles the second prize from one million dollars to two million dollars and multiplies all of the seven lower prize sets available in the game by the number drawn that evening. The jackpot prize is not multiplied.” The Powerball jackpot rolls to \$127,000,000 for the next drawing to be held Wednesday, Jan. 31 at 10:59 pm.
