Monmouth and Union County Jersey Cash 5 Tickets Split \$389,100 Jackpot

TRENTON (June 11, 2018) – Two lucky tickets matched all five numbers drawn splitting the \$389,100 Jersey Cash 5 jackpot from the **Saturday, June 9 drawing**. Each ticket is worth **\$194,550**. The **winning numbers** were: **04, 13, 22, 24 and 27** and the **XTRA** number was: **03**. Those tickets were sold at the following locations:

- Monmouth County: Spring Lake BP, 2004 State Highway 35, Spring Lake; and
- Union County: Jersey Lanes, 30 North Park Ave., Linden.

Acting Executive Director John M. White said, "We are thrilled that the winning jackpot tickets were sold at Spring Lake BP and Jersey Lanes. The retailers will receive a bonus check for \$2,000 for each winning ticket sold. Overnight, they have become two more 'lucky locations' for the very fortunate lottery winners."

White announced that there were 413,735 tickets purchased for the drawing. By adding XTRA, for an additional \$1.00 per play, winners are able to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by the XTRA number drawn. For correctly matching four of the five numbers drawn, 90 ticketholders won \$385 each and 16 others won \$1,155 each with the addition of XTRA. Moreover, for correctly matching three of the five numbers drawn, 3,108 ticketholders won \$12 each and 486 others won \$36 each with the addition of XTRA. Lastly 5,795 ticketholders each won \$2 for correctly matching two of the five numbers drawn with the addition of XTRA on their purchase.
