Mega Millions Rolls to \$161 Million

Six \$10,000 Winning Tickets Sold

TRENTON (June 13, 2018) – John M. White, New Jersey Lottery acting executive director, announced that there were **six third-tier prizewinning tickets** sold for the Tuesday, June 12 drawing that matched four of the five white balls and the Gold Mega Ball drawn winning the **\$10,000** prize. Those tickets were purchased at the following locations:

- Bergen County: Shoprite of Oakland, 14 Post Rd., Oakland;
- Essex County: Krauszer's Food Store, 357 Franklin Ave., Belleville;
- Hudson County: Newport Exxon, 726 Jersey Ave., Jersey City;
- Hudson County: Newport Exxon, 726 Jersey Ave., Jersey City;
- Mercer County: Gregory Liquor Store, 1772 East State St., Hamilton; and
- Sussex County: Market Place Deli, 99 Route 23, Hamburg.

If those tickets had been purchased with the Megaplier option, the prizes would be multiplied to \$20,000. The winning numbers for the Tuesday, June 12 drawing were: 01, 03, 05, 08 and 70. The Gold Mega Ball was 03, and the Megaplier Multiplier was 02.

In addition, 59 other players matched four of the five white balls drawn making each ticket worth \$500. Five of those tickets were purchased with the Megaplier option, multiplying the prizes to \$1,000. Moreover, 33,571 other New Jersey players took home \$155,528 in prizes ranging from \$2 to \$400, according to White.

"Congratulations to the lottery winners and to the retailers that sold the winning tickets," said White. "For selling the winning tickets, the retailers have become many more Lottery 'lucky locations' overnight."

The next drawing will be held Friday, June 15 at 11:00 pm. All New Jersey Lottery Mega Millions tickets must be purchased before 10:45 pm to participate in the drawing. Mega Millions tickets cost just two dollars; by adding the Megaplier option for an extra dollar per play, players can increase their non-jackpot winnings up to five times. Mega Millions tickets are sold in 46 participating jurisdictions. Drawings are held on Tuesdays and Fridays.
