PICK-6 JACKPOT REACHES \$26,500,000

Highest Jackpot for This Game Since 2004

TRENTON (Nov. 16, 2018) – Players of the New Jersey Lottery's Pick-6 game have a chance to win \$26.5 million (\$18.1 cash option) in the game's next drawing that will be held Monday, November 19 at 7:57 pm. The game's jackpot has grown to the largest up for grabs since May 2004, so players are urged to get a ticket and get in the game that offers prizes at all levels.

Nov. 15th's drawing produced 19 winners of \$2,381 all of whom matched five out of six white balls drawn. **Three of those tickets were purchased with XTRA, multiplying the prize to \$9,524**. Acting Executive Director James Carey announced that there were 904,847 tickets purchased for the drawing and of those sold, thousands were prizewinners!

The winning numbers for the Thursday, Nov. 15th drawing were: 02, 11, 15, 20, 45, and 47. The XTRA **Multiplier** was: 04. By adding XTRA for an additional \$1.00 per play, winners are able to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by the XTRA number drawn.

For correctly matching four numbers, 697 ticketholders won \$61 each and 107 others won \$244 each with the addition of XTRA. Moreover, for correctly matching three numbers 13,781 ticketholders won \$3.00 each and 1,899 others won \$12 each with the addition of XTRA. Lastly, 14,130 ticketholders each won \$2.00 for correctly matching two numbers with the addition of XTRA on their purchase.
