# Mega Millions Jackpot Rolls To \$252,000,000 <br> One New Jersey Lottery Ticket Wins \$1,000,000 

TRENTON (May 1, 2019) - The Mega Millions jackpot has rolled to \$252 million! James Carey, New Jersey Lottery acting executive director, announced that there was one second-tier prizewinning ticket sold for the Tuesday, April $30^{\text {th }}$ drawing that matched five of the five white balls drawn winning the $\mathbf{\$ 1 , 0 0 0 , 0 0 0}$ prize. That ticket was purchased at Welsh Farms \#25, $\mathbf{1 3 3 0}$ Main Ave., Clifton in Passaic County.

In addition, 27 players matched four of the five white balls drawn making each ticket worth $\$ 500$. Three of those tickets were purchased with Megaplier, multiplying the prize to $\$ 1,500$. Moreover 34,894 other New Jersey players took home $\$ 140,884$ in prizes ranging from $\$ 2$ to $\$ 600$, according to Carey. The winning numbers for the Tuesday, April $30^{\text {th }}$ drawing were: 24, 37, 41, 61, and 70. The Gold Mega Ball was 20, and the Megaplier Multiplier was 03.
"Congratulations to the lottery winners and to the retailers that sold the winning tickets," said Carey. "For selling the winning tickets, the retailers have become many more Lottery 'lucky locations' overnight."

The next drawing will be held Friday, May $3^{\text {rd }} 11: 00 \mathrm{pm}$. All New Jersey Lottery Mega Millions tickets must be purchased before 10:45 pm to participate in the drawing. Mega Millions tickets cost just two dollars; by adding the Megaplier option for an extra dollar per play, players can increase their nonjackpot winnings up to five times. Mega Millions tickets are sold in 46 participating jurisdictions. Drawings are held on Tuesdays and Fridays.
