- Sports betting
- Lottery
- Cards (often poker)
- Games of skill

## SIGNS OF PROBLEM GAMBLING IN TEENS:

- Unexplained absences from school/dropping grades
- Increased family conflict
- Asking/taking/stealing money from family, friends, and strangers
- Selling personal belongings to get money to gamble
- Showing off money, clothing, and other possessions
- Bragging about winnings
- Gambling language and gambling an important conversational topic
- Overly invested in performance of certain athletes (fantasy football/basketball/etc.)
- Overly interested in how various teams at school are performing
