\$2.9 MILLION REASONS TO PLAY PICK-6 WITH XTRA Jackpot Rolls to \$2.9 Million for March 20 Drawing

TRENTON (March 17, 2017) – Although there was no top prize winner for the Thursday, March 16 Pick-6 game drawing, there were 7 ticketholders who won \$2,712 each for matching five out of the six white balls drawn. One of those tickets was purchased with the addition of XTRA, multiplying the prize to \$5,424. In addition, thousands of other prizewinning tickets were sold.

The winning numbers for the Thursday, March 16 drawing were: 02, 09, 11, 20, 33 and 38. The XTRA Multiplier was: 02. The jackpot for the Pick-6 XTRA game has rolled to \$2.9 million. The next drawing will be held Monday, March 20.

Executive Director Carole Hedinger announced that there were 379,819 tickets purchased for the drawing. By adding XTRA, for an additional \$1.00 per play, winners are able to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by the XTRA number drawn. For correctly matching four numbers, 372 ticketholders won \$49 each and 53 others won \$98 each with the addition of XTRA. Moreover, for correctly matching three numbers, 6,995 ticketholders won \$3.00 each and 957 others won \$6 each with the addition of XTRA. Lastly, 6,751 ticketholders each won \$2.00 for correctly matching two numbers with the addition of XTRA on their purchase.
