\$3.5 MILLION REASONS TO PLAY PICK-6 WITH XTRA Jackpot Rolls to \$3.5 Million for April 10 Drawing

TRENTON (April 7, 2017) – Although there was no top prize winner for the Thursday, April 6 Pick-6 game drawing, there were 10 ticketholders who won \$2,173 each for matching five out of the six white balls drawn. One of those tickets was purchased with the addition of XTRA, multiplying the prize to \$6,519. In addition, thousands of other prizewinning tickets were sold.

The winning numbers for the Thursday, April 6 drawing were: 13, 16, 18, 27, 31 and 38. The XTRA Multiplier was: 03. The jackpot for the Pick-6 XTRA game has rolled to \$3.5 million. The next drawing will be held Monday, April 10.

Executive Director Carole Hedinger announced that there were 434,691 tickets purchased for the drawing. By adding XTRA, for an additional \$1.00 per play, winners are able to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by the XTRA number drawn. For correctly matching four numbers, 388 ticketholders won \$55 each and 44 others won \$165 each with the addition of XTRA. Moreover, for correctly matching three numbers, 7,037 ticketholders won \$3.00 each and 887 others won \$9 each with the addition of XTRA. Lastly, 6,753 ticketholders each won \$2.00 for correctly matching two numbers with the addition of XTRA on their purchase.
