## Mega Millions Rolls to \$137 Million

**TRENTON (Jan. 11, 2017)** – Carole Hedinger, New Jersey Lottery executive director, announced that there were no Mega Millions game jackpot or second-tier New Jersey prizewinners. The winning numbers for the Tuesday, Jan. 10 drawing were: 11, 20, 40, 41 and 59. The Gold Mega Ball was 15, and the Megaplier Multiplier was 05. There were three third-tier prizewinning tickets sold that matched four of the five white balls and the Gold Mega Ball drawn winning the \$5,000 prize. Those tickets were purchased at the following locations:

- Bergen County: Woodridge Wine and Liquor, 206 Hackensack St., Wood Ridge;
- Essex County: D'Allegro's Pharmacy, 252 Walnut St., Newark; and
- Morris County: Speedway #3473, 1552 Route 23, Butler.

If those tickets had been purchased with the Megaplier option, it would have multiplied the prize to \$25,000.

In addition, 22 other players matched four of the five white balls drawn making each ticket worth \$500. One of those tickets was purchased with the Megaplier option, multiplying the prize to \$2,500. Moreover, 81,555 other New Jersey players took home \$162,876 in prizes ranging from \$1 to \$250, according to Hedinger.

"Congratulations to the lottery winners and to the retailers that sold the winning tickets," said Hedinger. "For selling the winning tickets, the retailers have become many more Lottery 'lucky locations' overnight."

The next drawing will be held Friday, Jan. 13 at 11:00 pm. All New Jersey Lottery Mega Millions tickets must be purchased before 10:45 pm to participate in the drawing. Mega Millions tickets cost just one dollar; by adding the Megaplier option for an extra dollar per play, players can increase their non-jackpot winnings up to five times.

Powerball and Mega Millions drawings can be seen on WABC-TV stations. Mega Millions tickets are sold in 46 participating jurisdictions. Drawings are held on Tuesdays and Fridays.
