## \$6.1 MILLION REASONS TO PLAY PICK-6 WITH XTRA Jackpot Rolls to \$6.1 Million for May 29 Drawing

**TRENTON (May 26, 2017)** – Although there was no top prize winner for the Thursday, May 25 Pick-6 game drawing, there were 10 ticketholders who won \$2,441 for matching five out of the six white balls drawn. One of those tickets was been purchased with the addition of XTRA, multiplying the prize to \$12,205. In addition, thousands of other prizewinning tickets were sold.

The winning numbers for the Thursday, May 25 drawing were: 09, 19, 23, 25, 29 and 36. The XTRA Multiplier was: 05. The jackpot for the Pick-6 XTRA game has rolled to \$6.1 million. The next drawing will be held Monday, May 29.

Executive Director Carole Hedinger announced that there were 488,386 tickets purchased for the drawing. By adding XTRA, for an additional \$1.00 per play, winners are able to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by the XTRA number drawn. For correctly matching four numbers, 539 ticketholders won \$44 each and 67 others won \$220 each with the addition of XTRA. Moreover, for correctly matching three numbers, 9,223 ticketholders won \$3.00 each and 1,234 others won \$15 each with the addition of XTRA. Lastly, 8,322 ticketholders each won \$2.00 for correctly matching two numbers with the addition of XTRA on their purchase.
