## New Jersey Sells One \$1,000,000 & One \$50,000 Ticket as the Powerball Jackpot Rolls to \$206,000,000

**TRENTON (Jan. 30, 2017)** – There was one New Jersey Lottery ticket sold that matched the 5 white balls to win the \$1,000,000 second-prize for the Saturday, Jan. 28 drawing. If that ticket had been purchased with the Power Play Multiplier option, it would have doubled the prize to \$2,000,000. The winning ticket was purchased in Middlesex County at Woodbridge Raceway, 87 West Pond Rd., Woodbridge Twp.

The winning numbers for the Saturday, Jan. 28 drawing were: 12, 20, 39, 49 and 69. The Red Power Ball number was 17. The Multiplier number was 02.

In addition, one New Jersey Lottery ticket was sold that matched the 4 white balls and the Powerball drawn, winning the \$50,000 third prize. If that ticket had been purchased with Power Play, it would have doubled the prize to \$100,000. The ticket was purchased in Bergen County at Krauszer's Food Store, 10-16 River Rd. Fair Lawn.

In addition to the second and third-tier prizewinning tickets sold, there were 32,071 New Jersey players who took home an estimated \$158,732 in prizes ranging from \$4 to \$200, according to Lottery Executive Director Carole Hedinger.

"Congratulations to all of the lottery players who purchased winning tickets and to the retailers that sold them," said Hedinger. "I'd like to remind players to purchase their Powerball tickets with a winning attitude and add Power Play to the ticket purchase. Power Play doubles the second prize from one million dollars to two million dollars and multiplies all of the seven lower prize sets available in the game by the number drawn that evening. The jackpot prize is not multiplied." The Powerball jackpot rolls to \$206,000,000 for the next drawing to be held Wednesday, Feb 1 at 10:59 pm.
