\$3.5 MILLION REASONS TO PLAY PICK-6 WITH XTRA

Jackpot Rolls to \$3.5 Million for Jan. 9 Drawing

TRENTON (Jan. 6, 2017) – Although there was no top prize winner for the Thursday, Jan. 5 Pick-6 game drawing, there were 4 ticketholders who won \$5,519 each for matching five out of the six white balls drawn. If those tickets had been purchased with the addition of XTRA, they would of been worth \$16,557. In addition, thousands of other prizewinning tickets were sold.

The winning numbers for the Thursday, Jan. 5 drawing were: 14, 26, 39, 40, 42 and 47. The XTRA Multiplier was: 03. The jackpot for the Pick-6 XTRA game has rolled to \$3.5 million. The next drawing will be held Monday, Jan. 9.

Executive Director Carole Hedinger announced that there were 441,540 tickets purchased for the drawing. By adding XTRA, for an additional \$1.00 per play, winners are able to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by the XTRA number drawn. For correctly matching four numbers, 263 ticketholders won \$80 each and 37 others won \$240 each with the addition of XTRA. Moreover, for correctly matching three numbers, 5,175 ticketholders won \$3.00 and 686 others won \$9 each with the addition of XTRA. Lastly, 5,276 ticketholders each won \$2.00 for correctly matching two numbers with the addition of XTRA on their purchase.
