\$2.3 MILLION REASONS TO PLAY PICK-6 WITH XTRA Jackpot Rolls to \$2.3 Million for Feb. 27 Drawing

TRENTON (Feb. 24, 2017) – Although there was no top prize winner for the Thursday, Feb. 23 Pick-6 game drawing, there were 5 ticketholders who won \$4,115 each for matching five out of the six white balls drawn. One of those tickets was purchased with the addition of XTRA, multiplying the prize to \$20,575. In addition, thousands of other prizewinning tickets were sold.

The winning numbers for the Thursday, Feb. 23 drawing were: 02, 19, 29, 38, 41 and 45. The XTRA Multiplier was: 05. The jackpot for the Pick-6 XTRA game has rolled to \$2.3 million. The next drawing will be held Monday, Feb. 27.

Executive Director Carole Hedinger announced that there were 411,574 tickets purchased for the drawing. By adding XTRA, for an additional \$1.00 per play, winners are able to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by the XTRA number drawn. For correctly matching four numbers, 266 ticketholders won \$75 each and 35 others won \$375 each with the addition of XTRA. Moreover, for correctly matching three numbers, 5,341 ticketholders won \$3.00 each and 656 others won \$15 each with the addition of XTRA. Lastly, 5,596 ticketholders each won \$2.00 for correctly matching two numbers with the addition of XTRA on their purchase.
