## One Jersey Cash 5 Ticket Wins \$75,004 Jackpot in Gloucester County

**TRENTON (Feb. 28, 2017)** – One lucky ticket matched all five numbers drawn winning the \$75,004 Jersey Cash 5 jackpot from the Monday, Feb. 27 drawing. The winning numbers were: 05, 06, 11, 20 and 40 and the XTRA number was: 03. The lucky retailer that sold the winning ticket is Shop & Go, 109 Johnson Rd., Turnersville in Gloucester County.

Executive Director Carole Hedinger said, "We are thrilled that the winning jackpot ticket was sold at Shop & Go. The retailer will receive a bonus check for \$2,000 for selling the winning ticket. Overnight, they have become one more 'lucky location' for the very fortunate lottery winner."

Executive Director Carole Hedinger announced that there were 257,086 tickets purchased for the drawing. By adding XTRA, for an additional \$1.00 per play, winners are able to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by the XTRA number drawn. For correctly matching four of the five numbers drawn, 45 ticketholders won \$478 each and 8 others won \$1,434 each with the addition of XTRA. Moreover, for correctly matching three of the five numbers drawn, 1,843 ticketholders won \$12 each and 328 others won \$36 each with the addition of XTRA. Lastly, 3,797 ticketholders each won \$2 for correctly matching two of the five numbers drawn with the addition of XTRA on their purchase.
